**Provide** care to patients including assessment, investigation, diagnosis, treatment and partner notification.

**Deliver** health advice and referral to other health professionals or service as required.

**Inspire** others by setting standards for care by implementing protocols and establishing health education activities.

**Promote** equality and value diversity, identifying when own or others' behavior undermines equality and diversity.

**Share** quality in own work and encourage others to do the same. Keeping up to date with audits and data to send across weekly to the regional team.
